

The Team Point has the basic responsibility for speed, direction, etc. As a result, he/she is often scanning for landmarks, road signs, turn-offs, etc. The second bike in line in the right track has the best forward visibility and can spot potential problems early. A second set of eyes never hurts.

How many times have you been stuck in traffic on a wide-open interstate for no apparent **reason? It's what traffic engineers call "the worm.' It's just a function of the dynamics of traffic** flow. Even in a group of five bikes, we can experience the worm. If the number two rider daydreams for a second or two (never happens, right?), falls behind the point rider and accelerates to catch up, he/she creates the worm. Now the other bikes in the group must do the same, and pretty soon we have a gaggle, not a group.

The Team Point can create similar difficulties by accelerating too quickly after a stop, or on to a controlled access highway, or even just showing his/her speed to increase too much going down the back side of a long hill if the remaining riders have not yet reached the crest

Successful group riding takes special skill and lots of practice. Chapters that do it well are impressive as they maneuver smoothly through traffic or on the open road. And cool as they may look, they are also taking maximum advantage of the safety issues afforded to an alert team.



work done, we met with the Medical Oncologist, then went to the infusion center to begin the treatment. Dee is being treated with three separate drugs. The first drug takes 2-1/2 hours to infuse. After, a period of 1 hour is needed prior to beginning the infusion of the second drug. The second drug was supposed to take 1-1/2 hours to infuse... however, Dee began to have some adverse reactions to the first drug. So they interrupted infusion of the second drug and administered some other medications to help alleviate the adverse symptoms. Once Dee was once again stable, they completed the infusion of the second drug. Finally, they provided Dee with a small pump and "Fanny Pack" which is administering the third drug over a period of 46 hours. Dee will go back in on Friday afternoon... and they will remove the pump. So, that is the process ...which will occur every two weeks...four treatments total. Within 14 days of completion of Chemo, they will perform radiation...which will be done on three consecutive days..





We should all take the time now to ensure that we, our beautiful machine, and our gear are ready to ride. I believe you are all aware of my totaling out my 05 Wing last August, and the damage done to me. In May, I did a T-Clock on my 1500, donned all my safety gear, and made a nearly 200 mile ride. This was the first time on two wheels in 9 months. and I was concerned

about how I would do. I made the ride OK, but did find out one thing. The handle bars on the 1500 sat up higher than they did on the 1800, which raised my arms and shoulders. This was my first time riding the 1500, and I discovered that the higher handle bars raised my arms and shoulders up, which in turn had my broken collar bone area touching the bottom of my Helmet. I assure you, this was not a pleasant feeling for 200 mile ride. This my good friends, is one reason I recommend you


"CHECK EVERY-THING", and make sure ALL is ready before you ride.

With Wing Fling being up in the mountainous part of the state, those from the coast and flat lands need to realize that the riding will be different than what you are used to. (Continued from page 2) Educate them on our plight of "not being seen," and help make them more aware of us. This will be beneficial to all and it will also count as a "Motorist Awareness" activity on our Chapter's Rider Education Report.

There are a few of us – and we all know who we are – s eniors that require daily medications. Not only should you take those medications with you, but take a written

list of those medications, your doctor's name and phone number with you in case something unexpected happens. Please ensure you also have your written emergency contact list on the bike. It might be wise to also keep a copy on you, and please make sure it is legible. How about the "Gold Book"? This is a prime source for all kinds of helpful motorcycle riding information and should be kept on your bike at all times. Make

sure you also have at least one spare key with you for your bike I've seen several cases where the key was misplaced/ lost.

Each time we ride, let us be prepared for that ride until it is over.
