He never mentioned motorcycles specifically, but the issue of motorcycle tire pressure is an extremely 706-283-7533 important factor in rider safety. So, included in this short piece this month are some questions: Ways & Means Smitty and Janelle Ellis (1) Do you know (at an instant) the recommended psi for your tires? (2) When was the last time you checked the tire pressure before a trip/ride? (3) I'll admit that lying on one's back and getting under the side-bag to get at the rear tire value stem is a huge, huge pain in the neck (not to mention the embarrassment of trying to get back up), but how often do you check your tire pressure on both tires prior to a trip? (4) How often do you "check" your tire pressure simply by eye-sight (as in, "I've ridden so long I can see it if the tire pressure is off")? (5) Do you own a tire pressure gauge and keep it with your bike? (6) And, in a related way, how often do you check the tread-wear and condition of your tires? Some of us have been riding much longer than others. Perhaps you have other questions that we should be asking regarding tire safety. If so, please let me know or raise them during a chapter meeting.
